IF YOU HAVE NOT REGISTERED YOUR REWARDS CARD ONLINE

NOTE: We have a secured website, these procedures will apply to everyone who has not entered their email address and assigned a password.

1. Log in to <http://www.ralphps.com>
2. Click on **Services**
3. Click on **Community Contributions**
4. Click on **enroll**
5. If you are a new **ONLINE CUSTOMER**, you must click on **GET STARTED. SIGN UP TODAY** in the **'Create An Account'** box.
6. Sign up for a Ralphs Account by following the easy steps!
 - 1) Login Information (Your email address/password)
 - 2) Shopper's Information (Enter your zip cord to select the nearest shop)
 - 3) E-mail communication
 - 4) Confirm your Info
 - 5) Activate your account
7. Follow the next instruction

IF YOU HAVE ALREADY REGISTERED YOUR REWARDS CARD ON-LINE

(This means that you have already entered your email address and assigned yourself a password)

1. Log in to <http://www.ralphps.com>
2. Click **Sign In**
3. Enter your email address and password
4. Click on **'My Account'** (In the top right hand corner)
5. Click on **'Account Setting'**
6. Click on **'Ralphs rewards card'**, add/edit your card number. And then click **'Save'**
7. Click **'Community Rewards'**
8. Click on **'Edit Community Contribution Program Information'**
 - 1) Type **'90785'** and then click **'search'**
 - 2) In the **'Select Your Organization'**, click on the bubble next to our organization's name
 - 3) Click on **'Save Change'**
